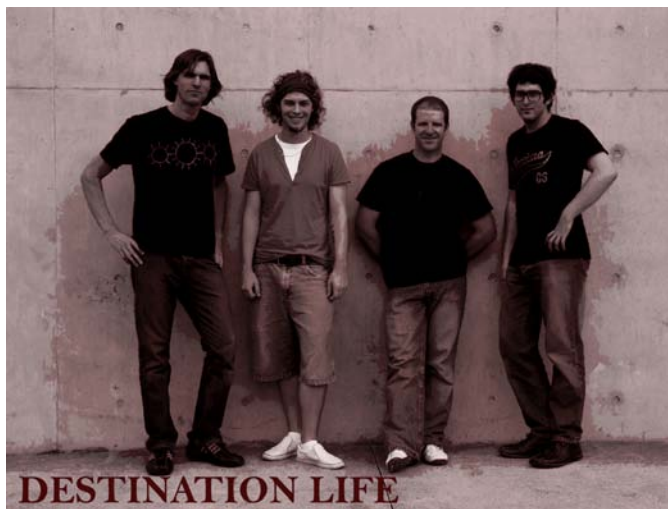

At school I wasn’t very good at much and I wasn’t living a very good Christian life. What changed my attitude was seeing Christ living out of my youth group leaders in how they cared about me and how they wanted to be friends with me even though they were in there 20s and I was a annoying 14 year old. Now I’m trying to do the same with the kids that I see. I have my flaws and teenagers see that quite quickly but I pray that they will look to the role model that I look to and that is Jesus Christ.
