The best thing though was that out of the 100 kids that were there 22 said they had made a commitment to follow Jesus and another 33 wanted to be followed up. That's huge!!

### **Chiefly College**

This was an easier gig in terms of playing. We only had to play 3 songs. There was 3 seminars and so we just played the same songs per seminar. They had a speaker James Fong who is from Youth Works. Towards the end of the day the kids started to miss behave but I know God can reach everyone and so hopefully even the naughty kids were challenged. I gave my testimony at this school.

### **Springwood and Winmalee Anglican Youth Group**

This was great. It was so much fun being able to play in front of my youth group and see them have a great time. This was a different challenge for me. This was on the same day as the Chiefly College gig so it meant it was a very long day. Start at 7:30am and went through to 11pm very tired at the end. God sustained me though. 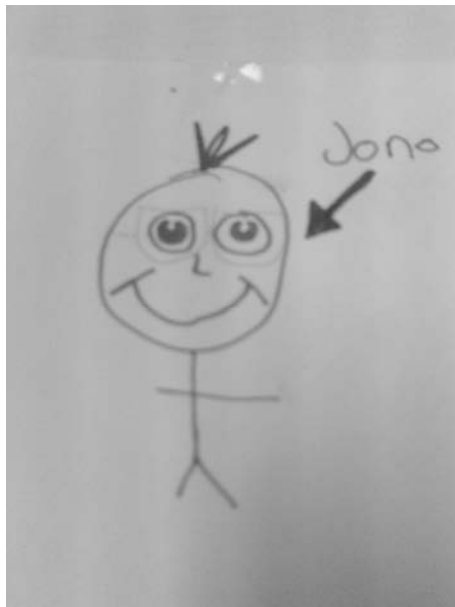
